



Theatre Buyout FAQs

Buying a theatre is a great way to have a private event for your friends and family, church, community group, etc. A "theatre buyout" means you will have an auditorium all to yourself to enjoy a private screening of the film with your group. Below are the answers to some of the most commonly asked questions about the theatre buyout process.

What is a theatre buyout?

- A theatre buyout is a private screening opportunity exclusive to your group.

When will JESUS REVOLUTION open in theatres?

- We will have an EARLY ACCESS night on Wednesday, February 22, 2023 in select theatres nationwide. EARLY ACCESS will include exclusive content created for the faith audience. To see if your theatre will be showing JESUS REVOLUTION for EARLY ACCESS, visit: <https://jesusrevolution.movie/>
- **We will open nationwide in theatres beginning Friday, February 24, 2023.**

What's involved in buying out a theatre?

- First, you determine what date and time you want to do the buyout. You can do a screening as early as Monday, February 20, 2023 and as late as Wednesday, February 22, 2023. Please note: Buyouts occurring from February 20-22, 2023 will include the exclusive content created for the faith audience.
- You will also need to determine a first theatre option and a backup option.
- Next, determine the maximum number of seats you would want in a theatre. Theatre sizes generally range from ~75-200 seats.
- Finally, fill out the online form at <https://jesusrevolution.movie/group-tickets> to indicate your interest.

How much will a buyout cost?

Ticket prices vary from city to city and theatre to theatre. Ticket prices are generally higher in major cities like Los Angeles or New York and lower in smaller communities. Ticket prices may vary depending on day of week and time of day. Please note some theatres may charge an auditorium rental fee or processing fee (upwards of \$500) in addition to ticket cost.

Do you know what showtimes will be available for the film at my local theatre?

Showtimes are not posted/official until sometimes 1 to 2 weeks prior to the film opening in your local theatre. It's our experience that theatres generally offer 4 or more daily showtimes including: an "early matinee showing - starts between 1:00 or 2:00 PM, a late afternoon showing - starts between 4:00 to 5:00 PM, an early showing - starts between 7:00 to 8:00 PM, and finally a late evening showing - starts between 9:00 to 10:00 PM. In most cases, you can work with the location to find a date and time that works best for your group. Please note that some theatres may not be as flexible in choosing dates and times.

What happens after I have filled out the online form to indicate my interest?

A representative from Lionsgate will contact you to begin fulfilling your request. Please note it may take up to 5 business days for a representative to contact you.
